**On Saturday, April 3, 2010, at 6:00 PM, the Lumber River Conference of the Holiness Methodist Church met at the Conference Headquarters, Pembroke, NC. Bishop James H. Woods was Presiding Bishop.**

**"Amazing Grace" was the opening song, prayer requests were given and prayers were heard. Welcome given and roll was called. The following persons were unexcused absences at the meeting:**

**OLD BUSINESS:**

- 1. Trustee's Report in reference to Conference Building's usage: Chairperson, Rev. Crites Oxendine, explained that other churches may schedule baptisms as long as they coincide with our own baptisms.**
- 2. Approval of Nomination of Conference Officers: Rev. Elton Hunt and Sis. Carvicous Barfield explained the duties of the Nominating Committee. After much discussion, Rev. Willie Jacobs, Jr., made a nomination to approve the nomination process and the Nomination Committee followed by a second from Bro. Rudy Freeman. Nomination Committee was approved. ## SUMMER CAMP 2010

Cherokee Chapel Holiness Methodist Church conducted its 2nd Annual Summer Camp July 5, 2010, through July 13, 2010. There were over 100 students, grades 2nd through 6th attending the camp. The camp is part of Cherokee Chapel Holiness Methodist Church's outreach program. The goal of the camp is to reach children who normally do not attend Church on a regular basis. At the end of the day, the children are returned home while other volunteers clean the Church and the Fellowship Hall to be prepared for the children for the next day. Everyone who volunteers does it out of a desire to please God, and do what is pleasing to Him. Ms. Victoria Huggins puts on a concert, free of charge, for the children. She and her mother have stated that this is part of their ministry, and they enjoy working with the children. They have agreed to participate each year and states that they look forward to it. In addition to all the other activities, there is a dental van that comes to the Church and the van is staffed and well-equipped to do work ranging from oral examinations and/or tooth extraction.
