- Goal of this class is to prep you to go and do Evangelism.
- Pray

You Know Christ, you are Growing in Christ now you want to Go share Christ.

1. What does it take to do Parking Lot Evangelism?

A. What is Parking Lot Evangelism? {[Sharing Jesus in high traffic areas](#)}

- a. Goal is to Plant seeds.
- b. Keep it about Jesus

B. How to do Parking Lot Evangelism.

- a. Scout
 - Survey to Parking lot
 - Record number of people coming out in a set time frame
 - Determine best place to setup teams
 - Overhangs if it rain
 - Set a reasonable/attainable Goal
- b. Teams
 - Work in pairs/ male and female preferred
 - Talker and Recorder/Prayer
- c. Driver
 - Gas up / Van is ready
 - Get the team to the location safely
 - Have Bibles / Snack bag / in Van
 - Pickup those who requested to come to church
- d. Team Leader(s)
 - The Team leader is the go to person for problems
 - Stay focused / Don't take it personal.
 - If someone asks for money / food / pay light bill
Send them to a Team leader(s)
- e. Seed Planters
 - You are handing out tracts etc, delivering message

- You are the one engaging with the other person
 - Ready to say Jesus loves you, share the Gospel
If pray requested always pray on the spot And most importantly ready to lead to Christ.
- f. Recorders (mini note book / pen)
 - Record how many tracts accepted/ rejected / male / female/
 - Record person's name and phone number for ride to church
 - church info pack ready to give if requested
 - g. Tool (Tract, Candy Bar, Life Savers, Survey)
 - h. Picture taker

2. Follow up

- a. Right after the event Team lead should collect data
- b. Discuss / Share experiences
- c. How can we do better?

3. Outcome Report

- a. Data
- b. Pictures
- c. Church Report
- d. Website Report
- e. Keep Data in a binder for future reference and end of year report

4. Preparing for the Event

- a. How to deal with conflict
- b. Emergency – Police arrive, compliant from storeowner
- c. How to approach people safely in a parking
- d. Comfort zone/ personal space
- e. Food Vouchers
- f. Event location
- g. Church Info Pack / Bibles
