Minutes of the April, 2012, Special Session

On Saturday, April 7, 2012, at 6:00 PM, the Lumber River Conference of the Holiness Methodist Church met at the Conference Headquarters, Pembroke, NC. Bishop James H. Woods was Presiding Bishop. Opening song was sung and prayer requests were given and prayers were delivered. Welcome was given by Bishop Woods and the roll was called. The following persons were unexcused absences at the meeting:

Old Business:

Passing of the Character of Ministers and Conference Members - As reported by Rev. Elton Hunt, all ministers are in good standing. He also suggested that we should call and give words of encouragement to Rev. Clyde Locklear as the problems that he had at the 2011 Annual Conference are now solved.

Nomination Committee Clarification – A nomination for a change in procedure was made by Rev. Steve Locklear that instead of individuals holding the positions of Secretary, Treasurer, Sunday School Supervisor and Lay Leader having to make application for their continued interest or anyone else

interested in these positions, that it is now be left up to the minister of each Church to make a recommendation to the Nomination Committee of someone they deemed eligible of any of these positions by the August Special Session. These nominations would then go to the Annual Session for confirmation. Nomination was seconded by Rev. Willie Jacobs, Jr.

New Business:

Insurance Coverage – Bro. Palmer Bryant had proposed a question to the Secretary/Treasurer concerning coverage of insurance should an accident occur while on a conference related trip. Since Bro. Bryant was absent, the Secretary/Treasurer explained his concerns. It was explained that a waiver is being signed whenever a trip is made and if an accident occurred, a claim would be filed with their personal insurance carrier.

Sis. Kathy Oxendine, Conference Lay Leader, made a request that Church ministers encourage children that are in musical training. There are presently eleven (11) students in training ranging from age 8 years old to college students.

Rev. Willie Scott, Jr., gave a report that someone had given some land to the Conference and it had been divided into thirty-nine (39) lots which appraised for \$215,000 and we have deed in hand. Size of each lot is from .6 acre up to 2 acre tracts.

The following discussions were made: Someone is interested in purchasing most of the land. However, the land does not “perk” but could be “built-up” and there are presently some mobile homes in the general vicinity.

A recommendation was made that the Conference could do one of the following: (1) Sell land, (2) Keep land, (3) Rev. Scott offered to purchase land and (4) Sell land to someone in conference. Rev. Elton Hunt asked that decision be made by the Trustees as to what to do with the land. Shoeheel is trying to obtain funds to construct a Fellowship Hall and it was suggested the land could be sold and help them in their construction of their Fellowship Hall.

Rev. Elton Hunt made a motion that a letter of appreciation be sent to the benefactor and this was seconded by Rev. Jimmy Locklear.

A report was given that work is still being done on Sis. Camma Morgan’s daughter’s house.

Motion was made to adjourn and seconded. **MOTION APPROVED.** Closing Prayer – Meeting Adjourned

Session began at 8:30 AM. Welcome delivered by Rev. Elton Hunt, Superintendent. Chairman of the Program Committee, Rev. Conclusion: If God brings us to it, He will lead us through it.

Joseph was put in charge of the household of Potiphar, his master. Joseph recognized that he had been chosen to be the steward of his master’s goods. He understood the great responsibility of taking charge of someone else’s affair, so he managed them as though they were his. He used all his master’s goods to promote his master’s welfare. All that he did was to benefit his master. Joseph realized that every steward one day must give an account of his stewardship.

Bro. Palmer as Conference Treasurer managed the monies of the Conference much like Joseph did for his master, Potiphar. The things he did, he did for the benefit of the Lumber River Holiness Methodist Conference. He was never satisfied with his Treasurer’s Report until every penny was accounted for, that was Bro. Palmer. He realized that faithfulness is the most important quality of the GOOD STEWARD. We, as the Lumber River Holiness Methodist Conference, thank you for your years of dedicated service in the position of Conference Treasurer.
