**Rev. Edward Bullard -** Because of a health situation, Rev. Edward Bullard was unable to get approval of the trademark for Conference Logo. He is to continue to work on getting the approval and hopefully by the 119th Annual Session.

**Rev. Anthony Chavis –**There was a question concerning the literature of what one church was using and our current Standard Publication. Rev. Chavis stated that before any new literature is introduced into the churches, the literature must be approved by the Education Committee. A watchful eye is needed for the Sunday School literature.

**Bro. Jennings Bullard –** Habitual absences for Church members – Bro. Bullard presented information from the study group concerning habitual absences for Church members. The group had made a proposal to be presented to the Bar. Each question was discussed. In the 5 questions proposed, all were agreed on except #3 (“willfully neglecting the means of grace”) and the question was to go back to the study group for a better explanation. To be referred to the August Special Session.

**Old Business:**

**Rev. Robin Hammonds –** Youth Pastor – Rev. Robin Hammonds, Sis. Twila Blakley and the youth directors from the Conference churches made the decision that at this time, a youth pastor was

Located on Highway 501 in rural Maxton, the property was formerly used as an Indian School and was deemed a good location for the Mission Church. Rev. Steve Locklear was sent to the location to work as a Missionary and organizer around 1971-1972. He later served as Assistant to Rev. Monroe Woods at Riverside Church and then Pastor at Union Chapel Church from 1974-1979. Rev. Steve Locklear was no stranger to change and was always willing to work where he was needed whether it be preaching, teaching or playing the piano as he did beautifully. It was through Rev. Steve’s urging and inspiration that Maxton Church started participating in the fifth Sunday singings.

Rev. Steve had the ability to play the piano through notes or by ear and was also talented in singing. In addition, he played the guitar, bass guitar, cello and the xylophone. His passion and talents with musical instruments could have easily earned him a role as a music professor. The Bible declares “Praise the lord with harp: sing unto him with the psaltery on an instrument of ten strings. Sing unto him a new song: skillfully with a loud noise”. Psalm 33:2-3

Bro. Steve, as he was affectionately called, was a self-taught talented individual who could fix almost anything that needed fixing around the home including his automobile. He was an active volunteer within the community servicing on the Tribal Council and advocating for a healthier Robeson County. He was looked upon in the highest esteem by many who knew him and like Job of the Bible; he experienced much suffering and afflictions of the righteousness, yet remained a man of integrity and piety.
